

# BOTTLE BAY RECREATIONAL WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETINGS

#### August 14, 2023

The Bottle Bay Recreational Water and Sewer District (BBRWSD) Annual & Regular Board meeting held by Zoom, was called to order at 4:03 p.m. by Chair Bill Berg, after verifying the required quorum. Board members present were: Bill Berg, Rob Behrens, Jon Davis and Steve Shearer. Also in attendance were RuthAnn Zigler, Recording Secretary. Absent: Jack Lensing.

## **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

There were no public comments.

### **CONSENT AGENDA**

Rob Behrens made a motion to approve the July 18, 2023 Regular Board meeting as presented. Steve Shearer seconded and the motion carried.

#### **REPORTS**

## **Treasurers Report**

Status of checking accounts and accounts in Local Government Investment Pool: The Mt. West Bank (2094) account balance is \$60,229.68, Mt. West Bank (8384) account balance is \$5,750.50, LGIP1 account balance is \$83,788.31 and LGIP2 account balance is \$166,198.96.

## **Operations Report**

<u>Status report on irrigation system maintenance</u>: We have sufficient lagoon storage to handling all influent, including precipitation and land application area is sufficient to handle estimated lagoon storage volume and influent. Our flows are up due to all the people that are here.

#### **Collections Report**

<u>Capital improvement program</u>: Overflow basin pump upgrade is complete; four (4) pump control upgrades have been completed with six (6) remaining; six (6) Airvac upgrades, with main line connection, have been completed with one (1) remaining; eight (8) mainline connection upgrades have been complete with two (2) remaining; waiting on budget reconciliation to move forward on tank replacement at Newharts.

## **Permit & Compliance Matters**

Oakley project is in process but we still need application and deposit within the next seven (7) days. Whitaker project is in process; completed the installation but contractor had questions and we need a set of "as-builts".

A second tank was found on the Augustine property that was up the hill from the steel tank we currently installed. The old tank is non-compliant. It was recommended that the District send a letter to the homeowner to inform them that the old tank is non-compliant and we will need to do a bypass of that tank and that they will need to remove the non-compliant tank because it is a safety hazard.

**2023-21** Rob Behrens made a made that the District require Augustine to mediate the danger of his old tank and the Sewer District be responsible for rerouting the line from the house to the second tank and put up a warning barrier. Steve Shearer seconded and the motion carried.

## **Public Hearing FY 2023 and Rate Schedule**

No public was present so Public Hearing was closed.

Resolution to adopt FY 2024 budget: A copy of Resolution 2023-22 was distributed to the Board for their review and comments. The proposed resolution is to increase the basic fee by \$2.00 from \$22.00/month to \$24.00/month and increase the service fee by \$4.00 from \$42.00/month to \$46.00/month

**2023-22** Steve Shearer made a motion to accept Resolution 2023-22 as presented. Rob Behrens seconded and the motion carried.

## Public Hearing for the annual FY 2024 Budget

No public was present so the Public Hearing was closed.

A copy of Resolution 2023-23 to adopt the FY 2024 budget was distributed to the Board for their review and comments.

**2023-23** Steve Shearer made a motion to accept the FY 2024 Budget as presented. Rob Behrens seconded the motion and the motion carried.

A copy of the proposed Notice of Ordinance Amendment and Public Hearing was distributed to the Board for their review and comments. The amended ordinance rationalizes how the District charges for extra facilities that are either attached to a dwelling, part of a dwelling or are detached from the dwelling. The full text of the amended ordinance is posted on the door of the Sewer District.

**2023-24** Steve Shearer made a motion to publish the amended in Notice of Amended Ordinance as presented. Jon Davis seconded and the motion carried.

#### Discussion

<u>Amended Rules & Regulations</u>: A copy of the amended Rules & Regulations was distributed to the Board for their review and comments; the Rules & Regulations mimic the ordinances.

<u>New website</u>: Steve reported that the website is functional but if you are using some of the Google searches and other means to get to the site it's not complete yet and shows that the page is not found.
